**MOTION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY**

**COMES NOW** Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through the undersigned counsel, and moves for the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") to cancel the certificate of service authority of T-Netix Telecommunications Services, Inc. ("T-Netix"). For its Motion, Staff respectfully states as follows:

1. On September 1, 2005, the Commission granted a certificate of service authority to T-Netix to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri via customer-owned pay telephone equipment in Case No. PA-2006-0021.

2. On March 29, 2012, the Commission received T-Netix's Statement of Revenue for calendar year 2011, in which it states it no longer wishes to retain its certificate of service authority. (See Highly Confidential Attachment A).

3. Because T-Netix requested cancellation of its certificate and is not providing services in Missouri to the best of Staff's knowledge, information and belief, Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate.

4. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo (Supp. 2012), which provides "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice

and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

5. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. W.D., 1989).

6. T-Netix is current on the payment of its fiscal year assessments.

7. Staff is not aware of any other matter that the Commission’s decision in this case will affect, or be affected by.

**WHEREFORE**, Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority of T-Netix Telecommunications Services, Inc., to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri via customer-owned pay telephone equipment.
