
Pursuant to Rule 4 CSR 240-10.080(7), the aforesaid parties request that state-specific revenues, tax identification and return information, and the access line counts in their respective reports be treated as highly confidential. As grounds for requesting highly confidential treatment of these portions of the annual reports the parties state that these portions of the annual reports contain company specific, state-specific information that is not otherwise publicly available. The information contained in these reports could be used by competitors of the aforesaid parties to determine the extent of business operations in Missouri, including the extent of network

facilities, and are of a competitively sensitive nature. Disclosure of this type of information to their competitors would be detrimental to the parties' business interests in Missouri. Tax identification numbers and tax return information are not generally released to the public. The confidential information contained in these reports is not otherwise in the public domain.


The reports are submitted herewith, together with the WorldCom 2001 Form 10-K referred to therein, with the highly confidential portions under seal.
