OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC COUNSEL'S REQUEST FOR LOCAL PUBLIC HEARINGS

COMES NOW the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) and for its Request for Local Public Hearings herein states as follows:

- 1. On October 15, 1999, Missouri-American Water Company (Company) submitted proposed tariffs designed to increase its rates for water and sewer service.
- 2. Company's tariffs, if adopted, would result in a rate increase of approximately \$16,446,277 annually, or about 54 percent in water revenues, and an additional \$2,363, or about a five percent increase in sewer revenues.
- 3. Because of the magnitude of the proposed increase, the large number of customers affected, and the number of customer inquiries received by Public Counsel so far, Public Counsel believes that the Commission should schedule local public hearings in order to allow members of the public in the Company's service areas an opportunity to testify concerning the rate increase and the quality of service presently being provided.
- 4. In order to ensure that the public has adequate notice of the requested local public hearings, Public Counsel suggests that the Commission order the following:
 - a. Notice of the time, date and location of the local hearing, along with information regarding the amount of the proposed rate increase and the

approximate percentage of the proposed increase, should be given to each affected customer, either by an imprint on the customer's monthly billing or a bill insert, or a separate mailing not more than 45 days or less than ten days prior to the date of the public hearing. Additionally, Public Counsel requests that the Commission order that the following information be included somewhere within the individual customer notices:

b. The newspapers in the relevant service areas, as listed in the current *Official Manual of the State of Missouri*, should be notified of the proposed increase as well as the date, time and location of the public hearing, not less than ten days before the date scheduled for the hearing, and should be requested to publish such notice seven and three days before the hearing in each newspaper's area;

c. Similar notice should be given to any radio and television stations in each area, not less than three days before the public hearing.

WHEREFORE, Public Counsel requests that the Commission issue its Order scheduling at least one local public hearing in each of the seven service areas of Missouri-American Water Company, more particularly, the cities of Brunswick, Joplin, Mexico, Parkville, St.Charles, St. Joseph and Warrensburg, providing adequate notice

to the public as requested herein, and for such other and further orders as the Commission deems necessary.
