The accompanying tariff sheet issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company), is being transmitted for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas Service:

These tariff sheets are being issued October 17, 2012 to become effective on and after November 1, 2012.

These revised sheets include changes to Company's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) Clause as approved by the Commission. These revisions reflect adjustments to the Regular Purchased Gas Adjustment (RPGA) and Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) factors for the Company's Missouri service areas.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's service areas, excluding the Rolla area, will decrease from 75.00¢/Ccf to 67.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will decrease from 54.77¢/Ccf to 40.82¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's Rolla system (Rolla, Salem, and Owensville) service area will decrease from 89.01¢/Ccf to 83.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will decrease from 56.02¢/Ccf to 42.07¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA factor will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The Missouri Public Service Commission issued its Order Granting Variance from Tariff Provisions, effective October 13, 2012 which authorized the Company to use sales volumes from a more normal period for its calculation of the PGA rate. Consistent with this order, the sales volumes from a prior ACA period, the 2010-2011 year, were utilized to calculate the firm transportation and storage component of the PGA.

Work papers supporting this filing are being provided to the Staff. Certain of the work papers have been designated "Highly Confidential" since they contain market specific information directly relating to the natural gas markets where Ameren Missouri must compete for its gas supplies. The Company requests that these papers be handled in a manner consistent with this designation.
