STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation states:

1. On December 21, 2006, Sage Telecom, Inc., filed an application with the Commission for approval under the provisions of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 of two negotiated amendments to an interconnection agreement with Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri. The Commission previously approved the underlying interconnection agreement in Case No. TO-2005-0287.

2. Section 252(e) of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 provides that a State commission may only reject a negotiated agreement (or any portion thereof) if it finds that the agreement (or any portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or if the implementation of the agreement (or portion) is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)

3. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff states that the amendments do not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the agreement and are not against the public interest, convenience or necessity.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission approve the two amendments pursuant to the Act, and direct the parties to submit any modifications or amendments.
