**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO STAFF'S
RECOMMENDATION**

On July 14, 2014, West 16th Street Sewer Company, W.P.C. Sewer Company, Village Water and Sewer Company, Inc., and Raccoon Creek Utility Operating Company, Inc. ("Applicants") filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking authority for Raccoon Creek Utility Operating Company, Inc. to purchase substantially all of the sewer assets of the other Applicants and to issue up to \$1,600,000 of secured indebtedness. On September 30, 2014, the Commission's Staff recommended that the Applicants' application be conditionally approved, subject to a number of conditions.

The Commission will require the Applicants to respond to Staff's recommendation, including the recommended conditions, and will provide an opportunity for any other party to file a response.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Applicants shall file a response to Staff's recommendation no later than October 10, 2014.

2. Any other party wishing to respond to Staff's recommendation shall do so no later than October 10, 2014.

3. This order shall become effective immediately.
