### REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE RESIDENTIAL FIRE SPRINKLER SERVICE COLLABORATIVE GROUP

Comes now the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and, on behalf of the Residential Fire Sprinkler Service Collaborative Group (Collaborative Group), states to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) as follows:

1. On June 16, 2010, the Commission issued its Report and Order in the above-referenced matter which, among other things, approved a Stipulation and Agreement entered into by a number of the Parties. One of the provisions of that Stipulation and Agreement involved the agreement to establish a Collaborative Group to develop permanent tariff provisions for Residential Fire Sprinkler Service. Specifically, paragraph 18 of the Stipulation and Agreement stated as follows:

"Residential Fire Sprinkler Service. MAWC will implement on an interim basis, new tariff provisions for residential fire sprinkler service. Those interim tariff provisions will be consistent with the provisions of the following specimen tariff sheets: Exh. 129, Weeks Sur., Sched. GAW-5, pages 17, 29, 30 and 31 of 31. MAWC, the FSA, Staff and any interested party to this case agree to work together to develop permanent tariff rules for residential fire sprinkler service. If the parties to the work group cannot agree

on such tariff provisions by November 1, 2010, then they will bring their unresolved issues to the Commission for adjudication.

- 2. Beginning in July, 2010, representatives of Staff, MAWC, St. Joseph, Riverside, Joplin, Jefferson City, and the FSA began a series of meetings or calls to discuss and develop permanent tariff rules for Private Fire Protection Service of MAWC, including residential fire sprinkler service. As a result of those meetings and discussions, the Collaborative Group was able to reach agreement on permanent tariffs for Private Fire Protection Service which will be filed with the Commission by MAWC on the same date as Staff is filing this *Report and Recommendation*.
