REQUEST TO HOLD PENDING PROCEUDRAL SCHEDULE IN ABEYANCE

COMES NOW Union Electric Company ("UE" or "the Company") and requests the Missouri Public Service Commission ("the Commission") to hold in abeyance the procedural schedule in this matter. In support of this request, the Company states as follows:

- 1. The Commission recently issued an order setting a procedural schedule in this matter.
- 2. The Company, the Staff and the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") have reached an agreement in principle on all outstanding issues in the second sharing period of the Second Experimental Alternative Regulation Plan (EARP) and have begun drafting a pleading to present to the Commission for its approval.
- 3. It is anticipated that the pleading will be similar to the "Joint Recommendation" or the "Stipulation and Agreement," which were filed at the conclusion of the first and second sharing periods, respectively, of the First EARP, and in the first sharing period of the Second EARP.
- 4. Because of the short time between the date that agreement was reached and the date set for the filing of testimony, it is not anticipated that the attorneys for the

5 2 Staff, OPC and the Company will be able to finalize the settlement documents and file them until the week of February 26, 2001.

- 5. The Company suggests that if the settlement documents cannot be finalized and filed by March 1, 2001, the Company will file a notice with the Commission indicating the status of that effort and the then anticipated filing date.
- 6. The Company has been authorized to inform the Commission that the Staff and OPC join in this request, and no other party objects to it.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set out above, the Commission is requested to hold

this matter in abeyance, pending the filing of settlement documents, or a further status report,

by March 1, 2000.
