ORDER STAYING ORDERED PARAGRAPH AND ESTABLISHING A HEARING

On February 24, 1993, the Commission issued a Report and Order in which it found that Sho-Me Power Corporation was in violation of Sections 393.190(1) and 393.250(1), RSMo 1986, by attempting to convert from a public utility corporation to a rural electric cooperative without obtaining Commission authorization for the conversion. In Ordered paragraph 4 of the Report and Order, the Commission directed its Staff to seek penalties in Circuit Court against Sho-Me for the violation.

To ensure that Sho-Me has additional opportunity to appear and address the issue of penalties, the Commission will, on its own motion, stay Ordered paragraph 4 and set a hearing for consideration of penalties against Sho-Me. The hearing will be held as scheduled unless Sho-Me files an application seeking the necessary authority for the conversion prior to that date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That Ordered paragraph 4 of the Report and Order issued on February
 1. That Ordered paragraph 4 of the Report and Order issued on February
 24, 1993 by hereby stayed.
- 2. That a hearing is hereby scheduled for consideration of penalties against Sho-Me Power Corporation, now known as Sho-Me Power Electric Cooperative, on March 23, 1993.
- 3. That if any person has special needs as addressed by the Americans With Disabilities Act please notify the Chief Hearing Examiner at (314) 751-7497 at least ten (10) days prior the hearing.

4. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
