## AMERENUE'S REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE JOINT AGREEMENT TO REMEDY IDENTIFIED DEFICIENCIES

**COMES NOW**, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE or the Company), and for its request to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) for Additional Time to File Joint Agreement to Remedy Identified Deficiencies, states as follows:

- 1. AmerenUE made its IRP filing on February 5, 2008.
- 2. On or around June 18, 2008, certain parties in this case filed pleadings alleging certain deficiencies with AmerenUE's IRP filing.
- 3. 4 CSR 240-22.080(8) allows 45 days for the parties to discuss the alleged deficiencies and develop a joint filing which sets for the remedies for the identified deficiencies as well as listing deficiencies which cannot be resolved (Joint Filing).
- 4. On August 4, 2008, AmerenUE informed the Commission that it needed additional time, until August 6, 2008, to complete the Joint Filing.
- 5. AmerenUE and the parties are still working on the language for the Joint Filing. Accordingly, AmerenUE requests the Commission extend the deadline for the Joint Filing until August 12, 2008.

6. With the exception of the attorney representing Noranda Aluminum, Inc., AmerenUE was able to discuss this motion with counsel for each party and no party objects to the requested extension.

WHEREFORE, AmerenUE respectfully requests that the Commission extend the deadline for the Joint Filing required by 4 CSR 240-22.080(8) until August 12, 2008.
