**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), through the undersigned counsel, and hereby respectfully submits this Staff Recommendation.

1. On October 22, 2010, the above-reference company filed a request that the Commission recognize its name change from Evercom Systems, Inc. to Securas Technologies, Inc. The company notified customers of the change.

2. The requesting company is certificated as a provider of pay telephone service, and as such is minimally regulated by the Commission. Section 392.520.1 RSMo 2010 provides that

The commission shall ... subject [pay telephone] services to the minimum regulation permitted by this chapter for competitive telecommunications services. The commission shall exempt the[m] from the tariff filing requirements of sections 392.220, 392.230, and 392.500 and may exempt the provision of such telecommunications services from the provisions of subdivisions (1) and (3) of section 392.390 and from the provisions of section 386.370.

3. Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060 establishes filing requirements for certificated company name changes; as noted in the Staff Recommendation, attached hereto as Attachment A, the Company has complied with the rule to the extent that it applies. No entities intervened to oppose the name change. The Company is not delinquent in any required filings with the Commission.

**WHEREFORE**, the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an Order Recognizing Name Change.
