Single Tariff Pricing / District Specific Pricing – Should the Commission a. keep the current water district structure, or adopt single tariff pricing for the water customers?

The Municipal League of Metro St. Louis ("the League") is an association of cities,

villages and county governments dedicated to improving the quality of life for residents within

the municipalities who are members. Its members represent 98% of the population of St. Louis

County and St. Louis City. The present rate case directly affects its constituents.

The League respectfully states and urges that the Commission should maintain the

current water district structure (maintenance of a separate St. Louis County district) and reject

single tariff pricing for Missouri-American Water Company's customers.

The League generally agrees¹ with the conclusions on this issue (rejection of single tariff pricing / maintenance of separate districts) expressed in the Direct and Surrebuttal testimony of Geoff Marke on behalf of the Office of the Public Counsel (Dkt. ## 67 & 146) and of Jessica York on behalf of the Missouri Energy Industrial Consumer (Dkt. ## 71 & 150) and with the

The League generally agrees with these conclusions relating to maintenance of a separate St. Louis County district and the rejection of single-tariff pricing solely for the purpose of this proceeding and without waiver of its right to assert at any time its own independent reasoning, later in this proceeding or in any other proceeding, which may differ from these witnesses' testimony. This filing should not be considered a verbatim adoption of their testimony by the Municipal League of Metro St. Louis.
