## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On September 27, 1991, the Commission received a petition for community optional service (COS) from the Irondale exchange served by GTE Missouri to the Potosi exchange, also served by GTE Missouri. On October 4, 1991, the Commission issued an Order Directing Calling Study in which GTE Missouri was directed to conduct a calling usage study between the Irondale exchange and the Potosi exchange. While processing the Commission's Order and reviewing prior study results, the Commission Staff discovered that the Irondale to Potosi route had previously been studied in November, 1990 in connection with Case No. TO-91-69, and had failed to meet the necessary criteria.

In Case No. TO-87-131, the Commission determined that two years must elapse after a particular route has failed to meet the criteria before another study may be conducted on that route. On November 8, 1991, based on the Commission's determination in Case No. TO-87-131, the Commission Staff requested that the Commission dismiss this case. Inasmuch as the Irondale to Potosi route is not eligible for another calling study until December, 1991, the Commission has determined that this case should be dismissed.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That this Case be hereby dismissed.

2. That this Order shall become effective on November 29, 1991.
