NINTH STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), by and through counsel, and for its <u>Ninth Status Report</u> states the following to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission or PSC):

1. After the Staff had filed a <u>Status Report</u> on May 9, 2006¹, the Commission issued its <u>ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE STATUS REPORTS</u> ("Order") on May 12th, in which it ordered the Staff to submit monthly status reports on or before the 15th of each month until such time as a recommendation can be filed, or unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. In compliance with the Commission's Order, the Staff submitted its <u>Second Status</u> <u>Report</u> on June 15th, its <u>Third Status Report</u> on July 12th, its <u>Fourth Status Report</u> on August 15th, its <u>Fifth Status Report</u> on September 15th, and its <u>Sixth Status Report</u> on October 12th, its <u>Seventh Status</u> <u>Report</u> on November 15th, and its <u>Eighth Status Report</u> on December 15th.

3. For this <u>Ninth Status Report</u>, the Staff reports that the District is contemplating several things at this time that include: 1) negotiating some amendments to the sale contract between it and Lincoln County Utilities Company; 2) meeting with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources with regard to a compliance agreement; 3) continuing its review and finalization of the preliminary engineering report, which has previously been reported as under review with some modification

needs already identified; 4) inspections of certain sewer pipelines; and, 5) using information from the above activities, determine a general concept of how to proceed with regard to the proposed sale.
