On July 1, 2008, the Commission issued its order approving the application of Lincoln County Utilities Co. (Lincoln Utilities) to sell its sewer/treatment facilities to the Public Water Supply District No. 1 of Lincoln County, Missouri (Water District). The order authorized Lincoln Utilities to cease providing sewer to its service area at the completion of the transfer.

On July 14, 2008, Lincoln Utilities filed a Notice of Completion of Transaction. Lincoln Utilities advised the Commission that the transfer of its assets to the Water District was completed on July 11, 2008.

As Lincoln Utilities has completed the transfer of its assets and no longer provides sewer service, the Commission will cancel its certificate of convenience and necessity and associated tariff.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of convenience and necessity granted to Lincoln County Utilities Co. is canceled.

2. Lincoln County Utilities Co.'s tariff, P.S.C.MO. No. 1 (Tariff File No. JS-2002-0033), is canceled.
