ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF CORPORATE NAME

On November 21, 1995, LDDS Communications, Inc. d/b/a LDDSMETROMEDIA Communications (LDDS) filed an application with the Commission requesting recognition of a change of corporate name from LDDS to WorldCom, Inc. d/b/a LDDS WorldCom (WorldCom). Within its application, LDDS has included copies of its Amended Certificate of Authority and Registration of Fictitious Name from the Missouri Secretary of State. In addition, LDDS states that the name change would have no adverse impact on its customers in Missouri.

On December 6, 1995, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve the name change. Staff states that it has no objections to the change of name and recommends that the Commission order WorldCom to file a notice to adopt the tariffs previously filed by LDDS, or alternatively, to file tariffs reflecting the name change.

Upon review of the application and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds the proposed name change to be reasonable. Thus, the Commission finds that LDDS' change of name to WorldCom should be recognized. The Commission also finds that WorldCom should file tariffs reflecting the name change or an adoption of LDDS' previously filed tariffs.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the change of corporate name from LDDS Communications, Inc. d/b/a LDDSMETROMEDIA Communications to WorldCom, Inc. d/b/a LDDS WorldCom is hereby recognized.
- 2. That WorldCom, Inc. d/b/a LDDS WorldCom shall file tariffs reflecting the name change recognized in Ordered Paragraph 1 or an adoption of the tariffs previously filed by LDDS Communications, Inc. d/b/a LDDSMETROMEDIA Communications within ten (10) days after the effective date of this Order.
 - 3. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
