#### ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

By its Report and Order issued in Case No. HO-86-139, the Commission authorized Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) to terminate utility steam service on December 31, 1990. The Commission's Report and Order also directed KCPL to make a good faith effort to sell its central station steam distribution system to a potential operator.

KCPL's efforts have resulted in the filing of an application to acquire and operate the steam heat distribution system in downtown Kansas City by Trigen-Kansas City District Energy Corporation (Trigen), and an application on the part of ECPL for permission to sell the steam distribution system and revocation of its certificate of public convenience and necessity.

In the Commission's opinion an immediate prehearing conference should be set for the purpose of determining a method and schedule of proceeding with the

instant applications. Notice of the prehearing conference should be given to Kensas City, Missouri, as a potential proper party. KCPL should notify all of its existing steam customers of the time and place of the prehearing conference since those customers have a substantial interest in the proceedings.

In the Commission's opinion it is unnecessary for the City of Kansas City or any representative from the customers to file an application to intervene in order to attend the prehearing conference. Applications to intervene may be orally presented at the prehearing conference. All parties to Case NO. HO-86-139 are decembed parties to the instant cases.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That a prehearing conference is hereby set in the instant dockets for the purposes herein specified, at 1:00 p.m., on August 11, 1989.

ORDERED: 2. That Kansas City Power & Light Company is hereby directed to give notice to its steam customers of the time, place and purpose of the prehearing conference herein set, within seven (7) days from the date of this Order.

ORDERED: 3. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
