This filing introduces certain existing Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint") services into the Embarq Communications, Inc. tariff, in support of the approved customer migration between the two companies. The only services being introduced are those to which migrating customers are currently subscribed. All customers have been previously notified of the upcoming migration.

Availability of all residential services being introduced in support of the migrating customer base is limited to existing customers and, accordingly, the services are being introduced into the obsolete (grandfathered) residential services section of the tariff. The services available to new residential customers were introduced under prior filings.

Two business services, Voice Solutions Service and Toll Free Service, will be offered prospectively to new customers as well as to the migrating business customer base, and are therefore being introduced in Section 6 of the tariff. Availability of the remaining business services introduced under this filing is limited to the migrating customer base and those services are being introduced in the obsolete (grandfathered) business services section of the tariff.


For those services with multiple rate elements, term periods, and/or commitment levels, only those rate elements, term periods, and commitment levels to which migrating customers are subscribed are included in the tariff. Therefore, the Sprint tariff contains certain regulations and/or rate elements that are not included in this filing. No customers, however, are impacted by the omission of those regulations and rates.

The terms and conditions of all services being introduced under this filing mirror those currently in effect under the Sprint tariff. All rates mirror or are lower than those currently in effect under the Sprint tariff. Specifically, certain Legacy Business Sense customers will realize a billed rate reduction, because the term commitment levels for this service are being collapsed. The one-year and three-year commitment rates for Dial-1, 800, Data and FONCARD are being reduced to Sprint's two-year commitment rates for the \$50, \$200, and \$750 spending levels, and the Dial-1 Business Sense Satellite Location Peak rates are reduced to Sprint's Off-Peak rate. Otherwise, the migration from Sprint to Embarq Communications, Inc. will be transparent to customers in terms of the services to which they are subscribed and the rates that apply.

The services introduced under this filing appear in a slightly different format than the Sprint tariff, with the regulations and rates for a given service appearing in the same section. There are also minor text changes in certain regulations to accommodate consistency and standardization, with no resulting changes in application or rates. Notably, regulations repeated in the Sprint tariff for each service are stated once in this tariff as applicable for all services unless otherwise specified for a particular service. As an example, Section 4.7.1B. of the currently effective Embarq Communications, Inc. tariff states "Unless specified otherwise for a particular service, all calls for which a minute of use rate applies will be billed in one-minute increments. Fractional minutes are rounded up to the next minute." This statement is therefore omitted from the regulations governing specific services. Likewise, references within a given service to the generally available operator services and FONCARD rates are also omitted, but are nonetheless applicable with no changes the actual application of those services.
