COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through counsel, and for its <u>Eleventh Status Report</u> states the following to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

- 1. After the Staff had filed a <u>Status Report</u> on May 9, 2006¹, the Commission issued its <u>ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE STATUS REPORTS</u> ("Order") on May 12th, in which it ordered the Staff to submit monthly status reports on or before the 15th of each month until such time as a recommendation can be filed, or unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.
- 2. In compliance with the Commission's Order, the Staff submitted its <u>Second Status</u> Report on June 15th, its <u>Third Status Report</u> on July 12th, its <u>Fourth Status Report</u> on August 15th, its <u>Fifth Status Report</u> on September 15th, and its <u>Sixth Status Report</u> on October 12th, its <u>Seventh Status Report</u> on November 15th, its <u>Eighth Status Report</u> on December 15th, and its <u>Ninth Status Report</u> on January 12th, 2007, and its Tenth Status Report on February 15th, 2007.
- 3. For this <u>Eleventh Status Report</u>, the Staff reports that board of Public Water Supply District No. 1 of Lincoln County (the District) has accepted an engineering planning report, and is commencing negotiations with the owners of Lincoln County Utilities Co. with regard to some modifications to the sale contract. The modifications would include extending some specified dates,
