PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), on behalf of all other parties in this case, and submits a proposed procedural schedule to the Missouri Public Service Commission.

On September 21, 1999, the Commission issued an order scheduling a prehearing conference of all of the parties for October 15, 1999, and ordered the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than October 28, 1999. On November 4, 1999, the Commission issued an order extending the date for filing a proposed procedural schedule to November 19, 1999.

Pursuant to discussions among the parties at the prehearing conference on October 15, 1999 and subsequent telephone conference calls, the parties have agreed that the issues in this case are primarily legal in nature, and that it is not necessary to file testimony in this case.

In a telephone conference call on November 17, the parties virtually agreed on a list of the issues that need to be addressed in this case. The list includes five issues, one of which contains two parts, and all of these issues are legal in nature. However, one of the parties to this case did not participate in the conference call, and another party questioned the wording of one

of the issues. It is therefore not possible at this time to submit a complete list of the issues at this time. Nonetheless, all parties agree that the issues can be adequately and completely presented to the Commission through the filing of a stipulation and the submission of two sets of briefs.

The parties have all agreed to propose the following procedural schedule:

December 17, 1999

Proposed stipulation to be circulated informally to all of the parties to this case. The stipulation shall be executed and

filed with the Commission as soon as possible thereafter.

30 days after filing of stipulation

Initial briefs by all parties.

20 days after initial briefs

Reply briefs by all parties.

WHEREFORE, the Staff, on behalf of all of the parties to this case, moves the Commission for its order adopting the procedural schedule hereinabove set forth.
