Executive Order 93-13 requires state agencies to undertake a "takings analysis" of each proposed rule or regulation in light of the United States Supreme Court decision in Lucas v. South Carolina Coastal Council, 112 S.Ct. 2886 (1992). Pursuant to that order, I have undertaken a "takings analysis" of the above-referenced proposed rule rescission. In Lucas, the Court held that state regulation depriving an owner of real property of all economically beneficial use of that property constitutes a "taking" under the Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments of the U.S. Constitution, for which the property owner must be compensated. The Court also held that when state regulations compel a property owner to suffer a permanent physical invasion of his/her property, such an invasion is compensable.

The proposed rescission deals with an existing rule covering recreational vehicles.

The proposed rescission does not implicate the takings clause of the U.S. Constitution, because neither rule involves the taking of real property.

PROPOSED RESCISSION

4 CSR 240-122.070 Inspection of Preowned Recreational Vehicles Rented, Leased or Sold or Offered for Rent, Lease or Sale by Persons Other Than Dealers. This rule sets forth the extent to which preowned recreational vehicles rented, leased or sold or offered for rent, lease or sale by persons other than dealers are subject to inspection by the director.

PURPOSE: This rule is being rescinded as a result of the passage of Senate Bill No. 19, effective August 28, 1999, which repealed all recreational vehicle regulations.

AUTHORITY: section 700.040, RSMo 2000. Emergency rule filed Nov. 12, 1976, effective Nov. 22, 1976, expired March 22, 1977. Original rule filed Nov. 12, 1976, effective Feb. 11, 1977. Rescinded:
