## AMEREN MISSOURI'S RESPONSE TO INTERVENORS' MOTION FOR LEAVE TO SUBMIT DATA REQUEST

COMES NOW Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri" or "Company"), and for its Response to Intervenors' above-referenced Motion states as follows:

1. Intervenors correctly point out that under the original, agreed-upon procedural schedule adopted by the Commission, a cut-off date for serving data requests, subpoena's, etc. existed. Intervenors have essentially asked for a waiver of that date with respect to their proposed data request, which seeks groundwater monitoring data addressed in Ameren Missouri's surrebuttal testimony. Ameren Missouri does not object to Intervenors' request for leave to serve the subject data request.

2. Ameren Missouri would point out that had Intervenors contacted the

undersigned counsel to see if the undersigned counsel would consent to service of the data request (or consent to Intervenors' request for leave to serve it) consent would have been given.

3. Ameren Missouri also notes that it has requested to depose Intervenors' witness Charles Norris and requested that he be produced without the necessity of serving him with a subpoena. Counsel for Intervenors has indicated she will produce him without the necessity of

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Ameren Missouri obtaining and serving a subpoena. Consequently, Ameren Missouri assumes that leave of the Commission is not needed given that issuance of a subpoena is not necessary.
