RESPONSE OF AQUILA, INC. TO ORDER DIRECTING FILING

COMES NOW Aguila, Inc., ("Aguila" or the "Company") and provides the following response to the Commission's February 7, 2007 Order Directing Filing (the "Order"):

On February 7, 2007, Great Plains Energy ("GPE") and Aquila 1. announced a definitive agreement for a transaction under which GPE will acquire Aquila's Missouri properties for a combination of cash and stock (the "Transaction"). The Transaction, which is subject to shareholder and regulatory approvals, is expected to close in about a year. Later that same day, the Commission issued its Order directing Aquila "to file a pleading advising the Commission what, if any, impact it anticipates the proposed sale will have on Aguila's pending rate increase request."

2. Aquila does not anticipate any changes to its rate increase request as filed. The operation of law date in this case is May 30, 2007, which is well in advance of the date by which the Transaction is expected to close. Moreover, before the Transaction can close, Aquila must obtain approvals from several federal and state regulatory agencies, including the Commission. Until all

required approvals are obtained and the Transaction closes, Aquila must continue to operate as it has in the past. Consequently, it would be neither necessary nor appropriate to make any changes to the Company's rate increase request.
