**ORDER DIRECTING CINTEX WIRELESS TO SHOW CAUSE WHY ITS  
ETC DESIGNATION SHOULD NOT BE PROVISIONALLY REVOKED**

On June 14, 2012, the Commission's Staff filed a complaint against Cintex Wireless, LLC, asking the Commission to revoke the company's designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) in Missouri for receipt of federal Universal Service Fund (USF) support for low-income customers through the Lifeline program as a wireless carrier. The Commission has notified Cintex of that complaint and has directed the company to file its answer no later than July 16, 2012.

Along with its complaint, Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to order Cintex to show cause why the Commission should not provisionally revoke the company's ETC designation so that any federal USF support it would otherwise receive during the pendency of Staff's complaint would be withheld. The Commission will grant Staff's motion

and will require Cintex to show cause why the Commission should not provisionally revoke its ETC designation pending resolution of Staff's complaint.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Staff's Motion for Order to Show Cause is granted.
2. No later than July 16, 2012, Cintex Wireless, LLC, shall file a pleading showing cause why the Commission should not provisionally revoke Cintex's ETC designation pending resolution of Staff's complaint.
3. This order shall become effective on June 20, 2012.
