**APPLICATION FOR LEAVE TO FILE
ANNUAL REPORT**

COMES NOW RDG Development, LLC (RDG), and, for its Application for Leave to File Annual, states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission):

APPLICANT

1. RDG is a Missouri limited liability company duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri with its principal office and place of business located at P.O. Box 932, Fulton, MO 65251. A copy of a certificate from the Missouri Secretary of State that RDG is in good standing was submitted in Case No. SA-2010-0096 and is incorporated herein by reference. RDG currently provides sewer service to approximately 33 customers in an unincorporated area in Callaway County, Missouri pursuant to a certificate granted by the Commission in Case No. SA-2010-0096.

2. RDG is a "sewer corporation" and a "public utility" as those terms are defined in Section 386.020 RSMo. 2000, and is subject to the jurisdiction and supervision of the Commission as provided by law. RDG has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court that involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within the last three years. RDG has no overdue Commission annual reports or assessment fees.

3. All correspondence, communications, notices, orders and decisions of the Commission with respect to this matter should be sent to the undersigned counsel.

APPLICATION FOR LEAVE

4. On December 9, 2009, effective December 18, 2009, RDG was granted a an initial certificate of public convenience and necessity in Commission Case No. SA-2010-0096. On December 28, 2009, effective January 1, 2010, in the same case, RDG's initial tariffs were approved for service.

5. Because RDG's tariffs were not approved for service until 2010, RDG provided no regulated service nor had any regulated revenues in calendar year 2009. RDG, accordingly, assumed that it was not required to file an annual report for the year 2009.

6. The Staff of the Commission has indicated to RDG that it believes RDG must file such a report. RDG therefore requests leave of the Commission to late-file the report. RDG will file the report form this same date.


7. RDG had no revenues or activities as a regulated entity in 2009. As a result, there should be no prejudice associated with a late filing of the annual report and good cause exists to allow a late-filing of the annual report, to the extent such a filing is required.

8. By providing a copy of this application to the Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel, RDG has provided a copy to all parties of record in pending cases before the Commission where RDG's activities are the primary focus of the proceedings (Case No. SO-2011-0012).
