Dial Around (10-10) Numbers

10-10 numbers can be a great asset for consumers that make international calls, consumers that don't have a plong distance carrier, or for people that want to dial around their current carrier. Using a 10-10 number means d 7 digit code before placing your call, and the four 1010 numbers listed below are **not** prepaid and the rates are same 24 hours a day 7 days a week.

These numbers are some of the best in the business, but no matter what 10-10 service you use, we suggest yo a moment and read Tips For Using 10-10 Numbers.

Remember that you can use as many 1010 numbers as you want (as long as they are available in your area), s needed, use different codes based on your calling patterns.

- 10-10-834: If you make international calls or state-to-state calls, this 10-10 number is great to use for dor calls at least 7 minutes long. All state-to-state calls are 3¢ per minute with a 39¢ connection charge. Mar state rates are the same. No monthly fee and no contract. Some of the lowest international rates availab anywhere for calling from the U.S. Click here for details.
- 101-5335: Excellent 1010 number to use for calls lasting 7 or 8 minutes and longer. Excellent internation rates. All state-to-state calls are 39¢ for the first 10 minutes then 4.9¢ per minute thereafter. Most in-state are the same, and there is no monthly fee, no connection fee, and no contract. All the details here.
- 10-10-629: This number has a higher rate of 5.9¢ per minute and should be used in combination with the three numbers and for domestic calls lasting less than 7 minutes. Great number to use to make sure you is available to talk, then call them back using one of the other three numbers. No monthly fee, no minimu connection fee, no contract. All the details here.

Important Update: Any month you use any of the above numbers, either alone or together, and you spethan \$3.00 in long distance usage, you will be billed a \$2.50 charge per line because of including the bill your local bill. This applies only to a month you have used any of the numbers and spend less than \$3.00 in use of there is a month you do not use any number, there is no charge at all. If you use any of the above numbers either alone or in a combination, and spend over 3.00 in usage, there is no extra charge to include the bill with y local bill.

Note: The carrier for the above 10-10 numbers has a policy of "Grandfathering" their customers, meaning if the per minute rate *increase* later, the rate increase will apply only to customers that had not previously used the se Once you use one of these dial around numbers and use it at least once every 3 months, you will stay in the ca system and if there is a rate increase later, the increase will **not** be passed on to you. What is even better, if the rate *decrease* at some point, you can call and be switched to the new lower rate. This is a great policy because dial around carriers will pass rate increases onto current customers and possibly not notify customers of the rate increase.
