CENTERLINE DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED ROUTE FROM BLACKBERRY TO WOLF CREEK 345 KV TRANSMISSION LINE WITHIN MISSOURI

A 150-FOOT-WIDE CORRIDOR THE CENTERLINE OF WHICH IS GENERALLY TRAVERSING ALONG THE FOLLOWING ROUTE LOCATED IN JASPER AND BARTON COUNTIES IN THE STATE OF MISSOURI GENERALLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING AT THE BLACKBERRY SUBSTATION LOCATED SOUTH OF SUMAC ROAD AND EAST OF MISSOURI STATE HIGHWAY 171 IN THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 33 WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, JASPER COUNTY, MISSOURI;

THENCE IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION ACROSS SUMAC ROAD THROUGH THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 19, ACROSS THYME ROAD, THROUGH THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 19, THE SE1/4 AND THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 18, ACROSS BARTON COUNTY BLVD AND INTO THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 7, TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 33 WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, BARTON COUNTY, MISSOURI;

THENCE IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION THROUGH THE NE1/4 OF SAID SECTION 7, ACROSSS SW 90TH ROAD, THROUGH THE SE1/4 AND THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 6, ACROSS SW 80TH ROAD, THROUGH THE SE1/4 AND THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 33 WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN IN SAID BARTON COUNTY;

THENCE ACROSS HIGHWAY 126 INTO THE SE1/4 SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 33 WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN IN SAID BARTON COUNTY;

THENCE IN A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION THROUGH THE SE1/4, THE SW1/4 AND PART OF THE NW1/4 OF SAID SECTION 30;

THENCE IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION THROUGH THE NW1/4 OF SAID SECTION 30, ACROSS SW 60TH ROAD, THROUGH THE SW1/4 AND NW1/4 OF SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 33 WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN IN SAID BARTON COUNTY;

THENCE IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION THROUGH THE WEST HALF OF SECTION 18 AND SECTION 7, TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 33 WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN IN SAID BARTON COUNTY TO A POINT APPROXIMATELY 400 FEET SOUTH OF THE NW CORNER OF SAID SECTION 7 WHERE SAID CENTERLINE CROSSES INTO KANSAS.

SAID CORRIDOR BEING APPROXIMATELY 9.5 MILES IN LENGTH AND ENCOMPASSING APPROXIMATELY 172 ACRES OF LAND.
