**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DATES FOR SUBMISSION
OF INTERVENTION REQUESTS AND STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On May 1, 2018, Elm Hills Utility Operating Company, Inc. (“Elm Hills”) filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) requesting that the Commission grant it a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain sewer systems in Johnson County, Missouri. The requested CCN would allow Elm Hills to provide sewer service to existing developments known as Rainbow Acres and Twin Oaks. The Commission will direct that notice be given and set a deadline for intervention requests and Staff recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Johnson County, Missouri and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.
2. The Commission’s Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Johnson County, Missouri and to the media serving Johnson County, Missouri.


3. No later than May 14, 2018, Elm Hills Utility Operating Company, Inc., Rainbow Acres Homeowners Association, Inc., and The Preserve Homeowners Association, Inc. shall file suggestions on how to provide notice to the customers affected by the proposed transaction.

4. Any application to intervene shall be filed no later than May 23, 2018.

5. The Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Elm Hills Utility Operating Company, Inc.'s application no later than June 29, 2018.

6. This order shall become effective when issued.
