UNION ELECTRIC COMPANY'S RESPONSE TO COMMISSION ORDER DIRECTING COMPLIANCE

Comes Now Union Electric Company, and in response to the Order Directing Compliance with Previous Commission Order, states as follows:

- 1. Subsequent to the Prehearing in this matter, the Complainant and the Company have worked together to provide the service requested by the Complainant.
- 2. Currently, it is anticipated that the Complainant will address the last remaining obstacle to the scheduling of the work and the work can be completed shortly thereafter.
- 3. The Company requests that this matter be passed for approximately 30 days for the parties to finalize the work and report back to the Commission. The Company would be more forthcoming with details about what has been done and what still needs to be done before the service can be provided. However, if a last minute problem would arise that prevents the matter from being resolved informally, the Company does not want to have improperly brought certain facts before the Commission.

4. The Complainant has been informed of the contents of this pleading and agrees with its intent.

WHEREFORE, since the matter appears to have been resolved informally, without the need for additional formal proceedings, the Company requests that this matter be passed until October 10. By that date, the parties will either inform the Commission that the matter has been resolved and request that the Complaint be dismissed, or that some additional time will be required before that dismissal may be requested. In any event, the parties will report back to the Commission by October 10.
