#### **RESPONSE TO STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

**COMES NOW** Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC"), and for its *Response to Staff Recommendation* states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

1. On February 25, 2022, MAWC filed an *Application and Motion for Waiver*<sup>1</sup> ("*Application*") requesting permission and approval for a certificate of convenience and necessity ("CCN") to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a water system and sewer system in Pettis County, Missouri in a subdivision known as Monsees Lake Estates Subdivision. The cases were assigned File Nos. WA-2022-0229 and SA-2022-0230.<sup>2</sup>

2. On March 1, 2022, the Commission issued its Order Directing Notice, Setting Deadline for Intervention Requests, and Directing Filing of Staff Recommendation ("Order").<sup>3</sup> The Order directed Staff to file its recommendation no later than April 25, 2022. On April 25, 2022, Staff filed a motion requesting until June 9, 2022, to file its recommendation. The

Commission granted the extension by order on May 16, 2022.

3. On June 9, 2022, Staff filed its recommendation for the Commission to grant MAWC a CCN with the conditions described in Staff's *Memorandum*, as granting the requested CCN is necessary and convenient for the public service.

4. MAWC has reviewed the proposed recommendations and conditions listed on pages 18 through 20 of Staff's *Memorandum* and states that it has no objection to the proposed recommendations and conditions.

**WHEREFORE**, MAWC requests the Commission issue an order approving MAWC's *Application* and granting MAWC a CCN as recommended in Staff's *Memorandum*, and for such other and further relief as deemed appropriate in the circumstances.
