Filling our cars with electricity will not only result in savings for drivers, but will keep money in our own economy.

In addition, if EVs are charged at the right times, they can improve the efficiency of our electric grid -- lowering rates for all utility customers. EV charging can also easily be matched with clean energy, like wind and solar.

I am writing to support utility policies and programs that will make it easier to own an EV in Missouri and maximize the benefits described above. Specifically, I request that the Commission support the following policies and programs:

- Large-scale deployment of EV charging infrastructure by electric utilities, so long as utility programs are designed to improve grid efficiency, reduce rates and integrate clean energy.
