RESPONSE TO ORDER

COMES NOW the Midwest Energy Consumers Group (“MECG”), and for its Response to the Commission’s Order Directing Filing of Estimates of Residential Customer Class Revenue Neutral Interclass Shift, respectfully states as follows:

1. On June 11, 2015, the Commission issued its Order seeking information regarding the revenue neutral shift associated with: (1) the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and (2) MECG’s proposed elimination of 25% of the residential subsidy.
2. On June 15, Staff and Empire filed their Joint Response to the Commission’s June 11, 2015, Order.
3. Through this pleading, MECG provides its agreement with the response provided by Staff and Empire. Specifically, as reflected in Attachment B of that Joint Response, the difference between: (1) the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and (2) the MECG proposed elimination of 25% of the residential subsidy amounts to an increase, on an average monthly residential bill of 500 kWh, of \$1.22. That difference increases, based upon monthly energy usage of 2,000 kWh, to \$4.44 / month.

WHEREFORE, MECG respectfully provides this response to the Commission’s Order.
