MOTION FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, and for its *Motion for Extension* in this matter hereby states:

1. Elm Hills Utility Operating Company (“Elm Hills”) filed an *Application and Motion for Waiver* asking the Commission to grant it a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) for certain service areas in Johnson County known as the Rainbow Acres area and the Twin Oaks area.

2. Staff issued several data requests (“DR”) to Elm Hills on May 30, 2018, which it received responses to June 22, 2018. Presently, Staff’s recommendation to the Commission is due June 29, 2018; however, Staff continues to review Elm Hills’ DR responses and determine if additional DRs are necessary.

WHEREFORE, Staff asks the Commission to grant an extension of its requirement to file a Staff recommendation to July 30, 2018; and grant such other and further relief as the Commission considers just in the circumstances.
