## MOTION TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW Aquila, Inc. ("Aquila" or the "Company"), and moves the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") to establish the procedural schedule described herein:

- 1. On August 4, 2004, Aquila filed its application in this matter. On August 10, 2004, the Commission issued an Order Directing Filing, which, among other things, directed the Commission to file a status report informing the Commission of a date certain by which Staff will file a memorandum.
- 2. The application for an accounting authority order ("AAO") that is the subject of this case concerns fuel costs that, in the absence of an AAO, would be expenses reflected on Aquila's 2004 books. To have any import as to the 2004 books, a Commission order would need to be issued prior to the date when Aquila's 2004 books will be closed. An order issued by approximately January 15, 2005, would satisfy that need.
- 3. Based upon early discussions, Aquila believes at this time, that this case should be put on a litigation track through the establishment of a procedural schedule. Establishment of such a schedule at this time would not foreclose other processes or outcomes that the parties might seek to follow in this case. However, it would provide a framework to bring the case to a conclusion in a timely manner.
  - 4. While Aguila has proposed its schedule to the other parties to this case, those

parties have, so far, been reluctant to discuss a schedule.

## PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

5. Accordingly, in the interest of moving this case forward, Aquila hereby moves the Commission to establish the following described procedural schedule:

Surrebuttal/Cross-Surrebuttal testimony (all parties)	October 21, 2004	
List of Issues, Order of Witnesses, Order of Cross- Examination	October 22, 2004	
Statements of Position-each party's concise explanation October 28, 2004 of its position on each contested issue with citations to the relevant pre-filed testimony		
Evidentiary Hearing	November 4-5, 2004	
Transcript due	November 19, 2004	
Initial Briefs	December 3, 2004	
Reply Briefs	December 13, 2004	

6. This schedule is designed to provide the Commission with the opportunity, if it so chooses, to issue a decision by January 15, 2005. Aquila believes that the overall time frame utilized in the proposed schedule is also reasonable. As stated previously, the Aquila's application was filed on August 4, 2004. A decision sometime around January 15, 2005, would result in a period of 164 days from filing until decision, or approximately five and one-half months.

WHEREFORE, Aquila respectfully requests that the Commission issue its order adopting

the procedural schedule proposed herein.
