**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING DATE FOR INTERVENTION,
AND ORDERING STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On September 17, 2020, Missouri-American Water Company (Company) filed its application for a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) and waiver. The Company has applied for a CNN authorizing it to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain sewer systems in and around the City of Trimble, Missouri. The Company has also requested a waiver of the 60-day notice requirements of 20 CSR 4240-4.017.

The Commission will issue notice, set a deadline for intervention requests, and direct the filing of a recommendation by the Staff of the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Public Policy and Outreach Department shall send notice of this application to the members of the media and the General Assembly representing Clinton County, Missouri.
2. The Commission’s Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the county commission of Clinton County and to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.

3. Any request to intervene shall be filed with the Commission no later than October 3, 2020. Such applications shall be filed with:
