ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On March 13, 1987, the Commission extended the service area of P.C.B., Inc., via a certificate of public convenience and necessity. In that order, the Commission directed P.C.B. to file tariff sheets describing the new service area that the Commission authorized in the order.
