

## PETITION FOR APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSIONERS TO ESTABLISH BOUNDARIES OF COMMON SEWER DISTRICT

Comes now the County Commission of Platte County,
Missouri, and, pursuant to section 204.250 RSMo. 1986, files
herein its resolution and order to begin proceedings for the
establishment of a regional sewer district and petitions this
court for the appointment of commissioners to establish the
boundaries for such a sewer district encompassing the entire
unincorporated area of Platte County, Missouri. Attached
hereto and incorporated herein as "Exhibit A" is the resolution
and order of the Platte County Commission dated December 26,
1991.

Petitioner further suggests to this court that the name of the proposed district be "The Platte County Regional Sewer District".

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays this court to appoint three (3) disinterested persons, one of whom shall be a licensed civil engineer or surveyor, as commissioners to lay out and define the boundaries of the proposed district, and that said commissioners be ordered, pursuant to section 204.260 RSMo. 1986 to hold a hearing at the courthouse in Platte County, Missouri, for the purpose of hearing any and all persons who wish to be heard as to the location of the boundaries of the proposed district, and to report back to this court upon completion of their duties.

# RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF PLATTE COUNTY TO BEGIN PROCEEDINGS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the County Commission of Platte County, Missouri has determined that the construction and maintenance of a common system of trunk sewers and sewage treatment facilities is necessary to secure proper sanitary conditions for the preservation of public health; and

WHEREAS, major portions of this county constitute a natural drainage area, the major portion of which lies within Platte County, a second class county, and which natural drainage area contains portions of several drainage basins, municipalities and sewer districts; and

WHEREAS, a common sewer district comprising the entire area would be eligible for federal aid and assistance under the provisions of Title 33, Section 1151 et seg., of the United States Code Annotated, 1971 Edition, as redesignated and as amended; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of such a sewer system of trunk sewers and sewage treatment facilities is necessary to guarantee the orderly growth and expansion of Platte County and to preserve its lakes, streams and natural waterways; and

WHEREAS, the issue of the creation of such a district should be presented to legal voters residing in the area sought to be organized and incorporated as a sewer district;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that this commission present to the Circuit Court of Platte County an application for the appointment of commissioners pursuant to chapter 204 RSMo. 1986 for the formation of a regional sewer district encompassing the entire unincorporated area of Platte County; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the suggested name for the proposed district shall be "The Platte County Regional Sever District".

#### REPORT OF COMMISSIONERS

Come now Wallace Beasley, Joseph H. Collison and Donald Soper, appointed by this court as commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "The Commissioners"), to lay out and define the boundaries of the proposed Platte County Regional Sewer District, and make the following written report to this court pursuant to the order of this court entered on December 30, 1991, and state that:

1. The Commissioners caused notice to be given by publication in the Kansas City Star, a newspaper having a general circulation within the area proposed to be encompassed by the Platte County Regional Sewer District, on January 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16, 1992, of a meeting to be held by said Commissioners at 7:00 p.m. on February 5, 1992, in the Platte County Administration Building at 409 Third Street, Platte City, Missouri, to consider and establish the boundaries of the proposed Platte County Regional Sewer District.

- 2. Affidavit of publication of such notice, setting forth the notice that was published, the name of the newspaper in which said notice was published and the dates of publication of such notice by the newspaper is attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof by reference.
- 3. The Commissioners held a meeting open to the public in accordance with the aforesaid published notice at 7:00 p.m. on February 5, 1992 in the Platte County Administration Building, at 409 Third Street, Platte City, Missouri, to consider and establish the boundaries of the proposed Platte County Regional Sewer District. All persons present, residing or owning real property in the proposed district, or adjacent thereto, desiring to be heard, were heard as to the location of the boundaries of the proposed district.
- 4. Following said meeting, and upon due consideration of the views of all persons wishing to be heard therein, the Commissioners have unanimously fixed and determined the boundaries of the proposed Platte County Regional Sewer District to be as set forth in Exhibit "B", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.
- 5. Attached hereto as Exhibit "C" and made a part hereof by reference is a map showing the boundaries of the proposed Platte County Regional Sewer District, as fixed and determined by the Commissioners subsequent to and pursuant to the aforesaid meetings, in relation to the property lines intersected or followed by them, and also in relation to city or county boundaries.

WHEREFORE, the Commissioners hereby pray that if this report and the attached map are approved by this court, that the court establish compensation amounts for the Commissioners and for the court reporter employed by the Commissioners and that the Commissioners be thereupon discharged.




#### PLATTE COUNTY REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT BOUNDARY


All that part of the unincorporated area of Platte County, State of Missouri, as that area exists on February 5, 1992, being more fully and completely described as follows:


Beginning in the middle of the main channel of the Missouri River, at a point where a prolongation south of the old boundary line of the state would intersect the same; thence north with said boundary line to line run and marked by Matthew M. Hughs, under an act of the General Assembly of 1838 and 1839; thence west with said line to the middle of the main channel of the Missouri River; thence down said river, in the middle of the main channel thereof, to the place of beginning; excluding all property lying within the incorporated areas of Platte County.


The boundary shall specifically exclude all property lying within the corporate limits of the following incorporated areas: the cities of Camden Point, Dearborn, Edgerton, Houston Lake, Kansas City, Lake Waukomis, Northmoor, Parkville, Platte City, Platte Woods, Riverside, Tracy, Weatherby Lake, Weston; the villages of Farley, Ferrelview, Iatan, and Ridgely.








