JOINT APPLICATION

Advanced Communications Group, Inc. ("ACG") and its wholly owned subsidiary, Feist Long Distance Service, Inc. ("Feist") (together, the "Applicants"), by their undersigned counsel, request Commission approval to assign ACG's interconnection agreement (the "Agreement") with Southwestern Bell Telephone Co. ("SWBT"), approved by the Missouri Public Service Commission (the "Commission") in Case No. TO-99-291, to Feist.

I. THE APPLICANTS

A. Feist Long Distance Service, Inc.

Feist, a wholly owned subsidiary of ACG, is incorporated in Kansas with its principal offices located at 110 South Main Street, Wichita, Kansas 67202. Feist is authorized to provide resold intrastate interexchange and/or competitive local exchange services in five states, including Missouri. In Missouri, Feist is authorized to provide intrastate interexchange and dedicated, nonswitched local exchange private line service. Further information concerning Feist was filed with its application for certification, filed in Case No. TA-98-332. That information is, therefore,

already a matter of public record at the Commission, and Applicants respectfully request that it be incorporated by reference herein.

B. Advanced Communications Group, Inc.

ACG is a publicly traded Delaware corporation with its principal offices located at 390 South Woods Mill Road, Suite 150, Chesterfield, Missouri 63017. ACG is a competitive provider of integrated telecommunications services, including local and long distance services, Internet access, and paging and cellular services, to small and medium-sized business customers primarily located in the Midwestern United States. ACG is authorized to provide resold intrastate interexchange and/or competitive local exchange services in eight states, including Missouri. Although ACG is authorized to provide competitive local exchange telecommunications services in those telephone exchanges served by SWBT within the State of Missouri pursuant to Commission Order issued in Case No. TA-99-49 (May 4, 1999), ACG currently does not serve any customers in Missouri. Further information concerning ACG was filed with its application for certification, filed in Case No. TA-99-49. II. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL TO ASSIGN ACG'S INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT TO FEIST

Due to changes in its business plans, ACG has elected to focus on its directory publishing business and plans to exit the telecommunications business. For this reason, ACG no longer requires an interconnection agreement, and requests Commission approval to transfer its interconnection agreement with SWBT to its subsidiary, Feist. The Agreement was approved by the Commission in Case No. TO-99-291 and the proposed assignment will not alter any terms of the Agreement as approved by the Commission. Additionally, since ACG does not have any customers in Missouri, the assignment of the Agreement will not affect any ACG customers nor any services offered by ACG.

Notice of ACG's intent to assign its interconnection agreement to Feist was provided to SWBT, as required by the assignment clause of the Agreement, on September 2, 1999, and is attached as Exhibit A. Also, attached as Exhibit B is a copy of the assignment clause from the Agreement.

5.0 Assignment

- 5.1 Provided that an assignee agrees to be bound by the Agreement either Party may assign this Agreement to a corporate affiliate or an entity under its common control or an entity acquiring all or substantially all of its assets or equity by providing prior written notice to the other party of such assignment or transfer. Any attempt at assignment or transfer is void ab initio. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, this Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the Parties' respective successors and assigns.
- 5.2 Each Party will notify the other in writing not less than 60 days in advance of anticipated assignment.

6.0 Confidentiality and Proprietary Information.

- 6.1 For the purposes of this Agreement, "Confidential Information" means confidential or proprietary technical or business information given by the Discloser to the Recipient. All information which is disclosed by one party to the other in connection with this Agreement, during negotiations (also see the Confidentiality Agreement between the Parties dated June 16, 1998) and the term of this Agreement, will automatically be deemed proprietary to the Discloser and subject to this Agreement, unless otherwise confirmed in writing by the Discloser. In addition, by way of example and not limitation, all orders for Resale Services, Network Elements placed by CLEC pursuant to this Agreement, and information that would constitute Customer Proprietary Network Information of CLEC's customers pursuant to the Act and the rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), and Recorded Usage Data as described in Attachments 5 and 10 concerning Recorded Usage Data, whether disclosed by CLEC to SWBT or otherwise acquired by SWBT in the course of the performance of this Agreement, will be deemed Confidential Information of CLEC for all purposes under this Agreement.
- 6.2 For a period of five (5) years from the receipt of Confidential Information from the Discloser, except as otherwise specified in this Agreement, the Recipient agrees (a) to use it only for the purpose of performing under this Agreement, (b) to hold it in confidence and disclose it to no one other than its employees having a need to know for the purpose of performing under this Agreement, and (c) to safeguard it from unauthorized use or disclosure using at least the same degree of care with which the Recipient safeguards its own Confidential Information. If the Recipient wishes to disclose the Discloser's Confidential Information to a third-party agent or consultant, such disclosure must be agreed to in writing by the Discloser, and the agent or consultant must have executed a
