STAFF'S RESPONSE TO ORDER DIRECTING FILING

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through counsel, and for its *Response to Order Directing Filing ("Response")* states as follows:

1. On May 21, 2010, the Missouri Public Service Commission ("the Commission") received a Rate Increase Request Letter ("Request Letter") from KMB Utility Corporation ("KMB" or "the Company").

 In its Request Letter, KMB requested Commission approval of an increase of \$18,500 in its annual water system operating revenues pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.050.

3. On October 18, 2010, Staff filed a *Notice of Agreement Regarding Disposition of Small Company Rate Increase Request* ("Partial Agreement") which stated that the Company and Staff were able to reach an agreement that included \$25,293 increase in its annual water system operating revenue.

4. On October 22, 2010, KMB filed Revised Tariff Sheets, with Tracking Number YW-2011-0214.

5. Subsequent to Staff's investigation and pursuant to negotiations between the Company, Staff, and Public Counsel, all parties were able to reach an agreement. On January 24, 2011, Staff filed the *Unanimous Agreement Regarding Disposition of Small Water Company*

Revenue Increase Request ("Unanimous Agreement"), which reflects an agreed-upon \$22,890 increase in KMB's annual operating revenues for its water system.

6. On January 24, 2011, Staff also filed a *Motion for Expedited Consideration and Approval of Tariff Sheets Filed on Less Than Thirty Days' Notice* demonstrating good cause and requesting the Commission issue an order adopting the tariffs with an effective date of February 1, 2011.

7. On January 24, 2011, the Commission entered an *Order Directing Filing* ("Order") ordering Staff to provide information that sets forth the effects of the Partial Agreement, the Unanimous Agreement and the tariff on the rates of an average member of each customer class by percentage and amount, as well as a list of specific tariff sheets of which parties seek the Commission's approval or order to file.

8. In response to the Commission's Order, James M. Russo, Rate and Tariff Examination Supervisor for the Commission's Water and Sewer Department, prepared Attachments A and B, incorporated by reference herein, as well as an executed Affidavit.

9. Attachment A describes the effects of the Partial Agreement, Unanimous Agreement and the tariff rates of an average member of each customer class by percentage and amount, including a base rate comparison and a bill comparison based on 6,000 gallons usage.

10. Attachment B provides the Commission with copies of the following proposed tariff sheets P.S.C. MO No.1:
