RESPONSE OF INTELEPEER, INC. TO REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

On September 1, 2010, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an Order in the Matter of an Investigation into the Quality of Wireline Telecommunications Services in the State of Missouri, File No. TO-2011-0047, requiring all local exchange telecommunications service providers certificated to provide service in Missouri to answer certain questions related to service quality, as outlined below. IntelPeer, Inc. ("IntelPeer") submits the following response:

A. Does your company own or maintain telecommunications facilities in Missouri? If yes, please answer all of the following questions. If no, then your survey is complete and should be submitted at this point.

IntelPeer does not currently own or maintain any telecommunications facilities in Missouri, as the company has not yet begun to provision telecommunications services in the state. IntelPeer plans to offer telecommunications services in Missouri in the first quarter of 2011. As explained in its application for certification, IntelPeer initially intends to develop commercial wholesale arrangements with underlying carriers to offer telecommunications services in Missouri, followed by its own facilities when justified by the business demand. Accordingly, IntelPeer does not provide any further responses to the other questions in the Order.
