**MIDWEST ENERGY CONSUMERS GROUP’S
RESPONSE TO ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSES**

COMES NOW the Midwest Energy Consumers Group (“MECG”) and files its response to the Commission’s Order Directing Responses dated March 5, 2020 (“Order”). For its response, MECG states as follows:

1. In its Order, the Commission asks each party to indicate its willingness to enter into a revised Stipulation and Agreement modified in specific ways. All of the proposed modifications relate to residential rates¹ and reports to the Commission concerning outreach to residential customers. As an advocate for large commercial and industrial interests, MECG was not deeply involved with the development of the residential rates in the Corrected Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and would have no objection to a revised Stipulation and Agreement that included any or all of the Commission’s proposed modifications.

¹ Paragraph 2 of the Commission’s Order does not explicitly state that it is referring to a residential rate, but in the context of the Order, and the on-the-record presentation of the Corrected Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement, only a residential rate makes sense. MECG submits this Response with the understanding that Paragraph 2 is limited to a residential default time of us rate.
