ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

Issue Date: January 22, 2010

Effective Date: February 1, 2010

On January 6, 2010, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting the Commission to cancel Jeffrey T. Blansit's certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the state of Missouri. In File No. TA-2001-106, the Commission granted Mr. Blansit a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service via customer-owned coin-operated telephone equipment.

Staff states in its motion that Mr. Blansit contacted Staff and requested that his certificate be canceled, stating that he is no longer in business. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel Mr. Blansit's certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service.

On January 7, 2010, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than January 19, 2010. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Jeffrey T. Blansit shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide private pay telephone service via customer-owned coin-operated telephone equipment granted to Jeffrey T. Blansit in File No. TA-2001-106 is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on February 1, 2010.
3. This case may be closed on February 2, 2010.
