ORDER RESCINDING ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE, NOTICE OF VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL OF MOTION, AND NOTICE CLOSING CASE

On March 25, 2011, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Commercial Communications Services, L.L.C.'s certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

On March 28, 2011, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than April 7, 2011. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed on or before April 7, 2011.

On April 25, 2011, the Commission issued its Order Canceling Certificate, effective May 5, 2011. On April 26, 2011, Commercial Communications filed an Objection to Staff's Motion. The company stated its certification is needed to maintain its status in the currently open Commission case, TC-2005-0067.

On April 27, 2011, Staff withdrew its Motion to Cancel the certificate of service authority following notification from the company, and asked the Commission to close the case without action on the company's certificate.

Based on the pleadings from the Company and Staff, the Commission has sua sponte reconsidered its Order. The Commission will rescind its Order Canceling Certificate, issued April 25, 2011. Because Staff withdrew its Motion, nothing remains for decision by the Commission. The certificate of Commercial Communications shall remain effective and this case shall be closed.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Order Canceling Certificate, issued April 25, 2011, is rescinded.
- 2. This order shall become effective on May 4, 2011.
- 3. This case may be closed on May 5, 2011.
