ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 13, 2001, Ozark Water & Wastewater Management Co., Inc. (OWWM) filed a motion asking the Commission to delay the procedural schedule previously issued in this case. OWWM requests an extension of approximately 45 days so that the parties may have more time to discuss and evaluate recent developments regarding one of the major issues in this case. OWWM indicates that the additional time may allow the parties to settle the case. OWWM represents that it has contacted all other parties and that none object to the requested extension of the procedural schedule.

Because there is no operation of law date by which time the Commission must act in this case, and because the motion is not opposed by any party, the Commission finds that the requested modification of the procedural schedule is reasonable. OWWM's motion will be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule filed by Ozark Water & Wastewater Management Co., Inc., is granted.
