ORDER REJECTING TARIFFS

On April 28, 2000, in case number ST-2000-694, the Commission issued an order suspending a proposed sewer tariff filed by Warren County Water and Sewer Company (WCWS). The proposed sewer tariff would increase the connection fee for new sewer service connections from \$150 to \$550. Also on April 28, in case number WT-2000-695, the Commission issued an order suspending a proposed water tariff filed by WCWS. The proposed water tariff would increase the connection fee for new water service connections from \$300 to \$700. The Commission issued an order on June 30 that consolidated the two cases. Both of the proposed tariffs carried an effective date of April 30, and were suspended by the Commission for a period of 120 days beyond April 30, to August 28. Subsequently, on July 11, the tariffs were suspended for an additional 120 days, until December 26.

A prehearing conference was held on June 7. WCWS did not appear. On July 11, the Commission established a procedural schedule that directed WCWS to file its direct testimony in support of its tariffs on July 20. WCWS has not filed any testimony, nor has it requested an extension of time

in which to file such testimony. Indeed, WCWS has never responded in any fashion to the suspension of its tariffs.

4 CSR 240-2.090(5) permits the Commission to dismiss this action for WCWS' failure to appear for the prehearing conference. Furthermore, Section 393.150.2, RSMo 1996, establishes that WCWS has the burden of proving that its proposed rate increases are just and reasonable. By its failure to file direct testimony in support of its tariff, in violation of the procedural schedule established by the Commission, WCWS has failed to meet that burden. Therefore, the Commission will reject the proposed tariffs.

So that WCWS will have ample time to respond if it wishes to do so, this order will become effective in twenty days rather than the customary ten.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the tariffs issued by Warren County Water and Sewer Company on March 31, 2000 (tariff file numbers 200000891 and 200000892) and initially suspended for a period of 120 days beyond April 30, 2000 to August 28, 2000, and subsequently suspended for an additional 120 days beyond August 28, 2000 to December 26, 2000, are rejected.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on September 20, 2000.
