ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES AND
DIRECTING ANSWER

All of the above-captioned cases involve applications from Fiber Four Corporation doing business under fictitious names for certificates of service authority to provide interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services pursuant to Chapter 392 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri. All of the cases involve not only the same party but the same issue of law: Whether the applicants shall be issued such certificates.

Thus, the Commission will order these cases consolidated. The Commission will also order the Applicants and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission to answer the application to intervene and motion to consolidate filed in each of these cases by AT&T Communications of the Southwest on July 30, 1999, no later than August 9, 1999, at 3:00 P.M.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Case Nos. TA-00-023, TA-00-024, TA-00-025, and TA-00-027 are consolidated for hearing purposes. Case No. TA-00-023 shall be the lead case.

2. That the Applicants and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission answer the application to intervene and motion to consolidate filed in each of these cases by AT&T Communications of the Southwest on July 30, 1999, no later than August 9, 1999, at 3:00 P.M.

3. That this order shall become effective August 13, 1999.

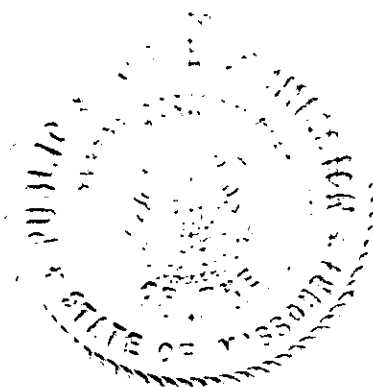
