ORDER DENYING REHEARING

The Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) established this proceeding on November 20, 1997, to develop the data to quantify the difference between District-Specific Pricing and Single-Tariff Pricing.

Evidentiary hearings were held on November 16 and 17, 1998. Initial briefs were filed on January 19, 1999, and reply briefs were filed on February 3, 1999. On August 11, 1999, the Commission issued its Order Directing Filing, and ordered the parties to submit proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Ordered paragraphs by September 10, 1999. The deadline for this filing was subsequently extended to September 24, 1999. The Commission entered its Report and Order on November 2, 1999.

On November 10, 1999, Ag Processing Inc. (AGP) filed its application for rehearing. No other party responded.

Section 386.500, RSMo 1994, provides that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." AGP has failed to establish sufficient

reason to grant its application for rehearing. The Application for Rehearing will be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Application for Rehearing filed by Ag Processing Inc. on November 10, 1999, is denied.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on December 17, 1999.
