ORDER ESTABLISHING BRIEFING SCHEDULE AND DIRECTING THE FILING OF EXHIBITS

At the conclusion of the hearing held on May 18, 1998, the Commission reserved three numbers for late-filed exhibits to be filed by St. Louis County Water Company. Late-filed Exhibit No. 9 has been reserved for the record of dividends issued from 1995 to the most current time period, late-filed Exhibit No. 10 has been reserved for the "1994 plan", and late-filed Exhibit No. 11 has been reserved for the spreadsheet titled St. Louis County Water Company Main Incidents Excluding Contractor Incidents. These late-filed exhibits shall be submitted to the Regulatory Law Judge no later than June 24. Any objections to the late-filed exhibits must be filed no later than July 6.

Because the deadlines for filing the late-filed exhibits and objections to the exhibits will not allow the parties an opportunity to refer to the exhibits in their briefs pursuant to the briefing schedule agreed to by the parties at the close of the hearing, the Commission will extend those deadlines. Initial briefs will be due on July 13 and reply briefs will be due on July 27.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That St. Louis County Water Company shall provide the Regulatory Law Judge with nine copies of late-filed Exhibit Nos. 9, 10, and 11 no later than June 24, 1998.
2. That objections to the late-filed exhibits shall be filed with the Commission no later than July 6, 1998.
3. That initial briefs shall be due on July 13, 1998.
4. That reply briefs shall be due on July 27, 1998.
5. That this order shall become effective on June 19, 1998.
