ORDER SETTING EARLY PREHEARING CONFERENCE

GTE Midwest Incorporated answered that complaint on December 26, pointing out that it, rather than GTE Corporation, was the proper defendant. The First Amended Complaint replaced GTE Corporation with GTE Midwest Incorporated as the respondent, and GTE Midwest Incorporated's January 23 pleading was its answer to the First Amended Complaint.
