**ORDER ESTABLISHING CASE
AND CANCELING PRIVATE PAYPHONE CERTIFICATE**

Steven Ray Smith submitted his Statement of Revenue to the Missouri Public Service Commission on or about May 14, 1997. On the Statement of Revenue, Steven Ray Smith wrote a notation in which he asked the Commission to cancel his payphone certificate as he was no longer in the payphone business. Steven Ray Smith was granted the certificate on June 15, 1995, in Case No. TA-95-343. The Staff of the Commission advised the Commission that it had attempted to make contact with the certificate holder but was unable to do so as he had moved and Directory Assistance had no new telephone number for him. The Staff also informed the Commission it recommended that the certificate should be canceled because Steven Ray Smith was no longer in the payphone business in Missouri.

The original case file in TA-95-343 has been archived and is no longer available for the entry of an order. The Commission will establish a new case for the purpose of maintaining a record of this certificate cancellation. Section 392.410, RSMo Supp. 1997 gives the Commission authority over the granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed Steven Ray Smith's Statement of Revenue and Staff's comments

and finds that the private payphone certificate granted to Steven Ray Smith in Case No. TA-95-343 shall be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That this case is established for the purpose of maintaining a record of the certificate cancellation.
2. That the private payphone certificate granted to Steven Ray Smith in Case No. TA-95-343 is canceled.
3. That this order shall become effective on July 24, 1998.
4. That this case may be closed on July 27, 1998.
